What is Design-Build?

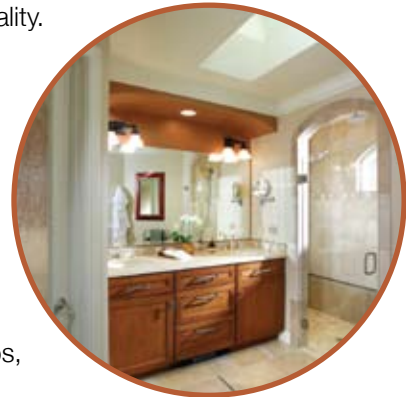

How the Design Process Works



Tiffany De Tomasi, CKD, CBD

Tiffany De Tomasi, Fisher Construction's Senior Designer, is certified by the National Kitchen and Bath Association as a Certified Kitchen Designer and Certified Bathroom Designer. Designers undergo a rigorous process to qualify for certification. They must demonstrate years of experience in kitchen and bathroom design; pass an intensive, comprehensive exam consisting of both academic and drafting sections; adhere to a strict code of professional conduct and continually further their education. Tiffany is an Interior Design graduate of the Fashion Institute of Design and Merchandising Design (FIDM) in San Francisco. She has been selected as one of the Top 100 designers in the U.S. and her work has been featured in *Kitchens by Professional Designers, Books XIV and XVI*, and can be seen in *The Kitchen Collection, Book I*.

Fisher Construction approaches each design project as a fresh challenge—an opportunity to satisfy the many functional needs for a space while exploring new possibilities in color, texture, scale and layout. The following is an overview of how we work with our clients to help make remodeling dreams a reality.

At an initial meeting, we introduce you to Fisher Construction's extensive portfolio. This first step opens your eyes to the many possibilities available for your remodel. We give you an overview of the design and production process, explaining step-by-step how we plan and organize your remodel to make the project run smoothly and efficiently. We talk to you about how your current space works and doesn't work and what you hope your remodel will accomplish. Lifestyle questions—such as how many cooks use your kitchen, or how you like to entertain friends—help us determine the best solutions for your space. Often, Tiffany will ask for pictures of kitchens or baths that you have seen and liked, enhancing her understanding of your ideals for style and functionality.

At this stage, we discuss your budget and your desires and how they can best be balanced, taking into consideration such factors as the kinds of materials you want to use and what kind of floor plan we are considering. Once you have made the decision to sign a contract with Fisher Construction, we move on to measuring and taking photos of your space as our final step before drawing up plans.

During the design process, we guide you through decisions about cabinetry, countertops, flooring, storage, appliances and all the other details that make your remodeling dream a reality. We help you research appliances and go with you to the appropriate stores to shop for your choices. You will be invited for a visit to our private showroom where you can see and feel the many options available to you for types of moldings, door styles, cabinets, and more. If you've chosen granite for your remodel, you will have the opportunity to visit one of the many stone yards we work with throughout the Bay Area and choose your very own custom slab.
